The five-year cost for Trailblazing Morris County is a minimum of \$1.0 million invested by the private sector and in partnership with the funding by the public sector of Morris County. We will ask the area's businesses, individuals, institutions, civic groups, and foundations to invest in this economic development program. We will base each investment request on the individual investor's stake in the community and economic development enhancements that accrue to the region because of the program. An Investor Advisory Council has been formed for additional guidance and input opportunities to the Board of Directors.

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ACCEPTANCE LETTER FOR FHLBANK GRANT AWARD

Greater Morris County Development Corporation awarded \$408,360 grant through FHLBank Topeka for homeowner rehabilitation.

The Greater Morris County Development Corporation has been awarded \$408,360 to assist homeowners across Morris County for the rehabilitation or replacement of interior and exterior of homeowner-occupied housing. Thanks to our Member Partner, Farmers and Drovers Bank, we can award these grants to homeowners to assist in the following repairs.

- · Roof, gutter and siding repair or replacement
- Exterior doors and window repair or replacement
- Accessibility modifications
- Emergency repairs
- Sewer/septic tank repair

Often due to limited budgets and physical restrictions, homeowners are unable to make basic repairs on their homes. By addressing these basic repairs often and early, we hope to reduce the need for critical repairs and assist homeowners in the ability to live in their homes without environmental concerns or structural risks. The benefits of our home repair program will allow families to live in a safe and well-maintained home. Neighborhoods become revitalized and affordable housing inventory across the State of Kansas is preserved.

Applicants must be the owner of the home and currently residing in the home. Qualifications are simple, the applicant must be income eligible less than 80% of the area median income, property taxes must be current, and the home must be owner occupied. The maximum household income can not exceed \$56,300.00 for a household of four and \$74,000.00 for a household of five or more.

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PITCH YOUR PORCH (PYP)

This year we held the Pitch Your Porch (PYP) competition. This was a pilot program that was sponsored by Network Kansas. We had \$15,000 in funds to award five Morris County businesses in the amount of \$3,000 each. We had 11 businesses pitch the front facades of their businesses in hopes to use the allocated grant funds to update their "front porches". The winners pictured below (from left to right) were The Market on Main, Peterson Lumber, The Territory Ballroom, LK Liquors, and Pink Gravel, LLC. We held the event at The Dealership Building on Main St. in Council Grove. We heard some amazing pitches and we wish we could have given all of the participating businesses some funds. While there were only five businesses that were "winners" there was a major benefit for all of the businesses who attended. They all heard each other's needs, Pitch Your Porch has allowed our local businesses in Morris County to help one another with future projects. We hope to hold Pitch Your Porch annually to encourage participation and to assist our entrepreneurs in Morris County.


